Political activities

Overview of political activities

Justice for men & boys (and the women who love them) is the only political party in the English-speaking world actively campaigning for the human rights of men and boys. Those rights have been systematically and relentlessly assaulted by the state's action and inactions in the UK for the past 30+ years, as they have across the developed world.

The party was launched in February 2013, and the first accounting period - to end December 2013 - covered a period of increasing media exposure and the start of the development of analyses and policy positions in readiness for the party's manifesto.

2014 was a period of remarkable progress in our analyses of the problems facing men and boys (and the women who love them), and the further development of policy positions. Our 80-page manifesto, covering 20 problem areas for men and boys (and sometimes girls) was published on the party's website in December 2014, and published as an ebook in January 2015. It has attracted many favourable responses.

I should like to thank all the many people who have helped us propel the party forward. They include donors - donations in 2014 were about 50% higher than in 2013 - contributors of written materials, and suppliers of goods and services. In the past two years we've been interviewed on TV or radio on more than 100 occasions - the video and audio files are n our YouTube library - and I was recently commissioned by the *International Business times* to write a fortnightly column on men's issues. Three documentaries about men's issues and/or feminism are being filmed. They're going to be broadcast later this year, or early 2016.

We look forward to standing at the general election on 7 May in three adjacent highly marginal seats near Nottingham. One key objective is to raise the public profile of J4MB, with a view to fielding many more candidates at the 2020 general election. I'll be standing in Ashfield, the seat of Gloria De Piero (L), the Shadow Minister for Women and Equalities. Ray Barry, leader of Real Fathers for Justice, will be standing in Broxtowe, the seat of Anna Soubry (C). Ian Young, a survivor of domestic violence over many years, will be standing in Sherwood, the seat of Mark Spencer (C). We have calculated that had we stood for election in 2010, we would have had to secure only 400 votes from the three sitting MPs collectively to have denied them election.
