Overview of political activities	

Justice for Men & Boys (and the women who love them) - 'J4MB' remains the only political party in the English-speaking world campaigning for the human rights of men and boys. We campaign on many fronts and in our 2015 general election manifesto we explored 20 areas where the human rights of men and boys are assaulted by the state, usually to advantage women and girls. There are no areas in which the state *specifically* assaults the human rights of women and girls, giving the lie to the deeply flawed and nonsensical assertion of patriarchal domination of women by men.

2017 was another busy year for the party. Mike Buchanan spoke at the third International Conference on Men's Issues, in Gold Coast, Australia.

Party membership continues to be our prime source of funding.

We maintained our policy of only challenging the party in power between general elections, because only that party can end the relentless assaults on the human rights of men and boys.

We maintained the non-therapeutic circumcision of male minors (Male Genital Mutilation, 'MGM') as our foremost campaigning issue. The practice is unquestionably illegal in the UK - under the Offences Against the Person Act 1861 - yet the CPS/police do not bring prosecutions against those performing the procedures. It is an outrage that Female Genital Mutilation is specifically illegal in this country whilst mutilation of male minors' genitals, with its attendant risks and suffering, continues unabated.

On 1 June 2016, in the course of an anti-MGM protest in Parliament Square, Mike Buchanan obstructed a few motorists for a short time, in connection with the failure of the CPS/police to bring prosecutions against those who carry out circumcisions, and was arrested. This later resulted in a conviction, which was appealed, unsuccessfully, at a Crown Court. Another appeal is to be heard in the High Court in London, on 10 July, 2018.

Finally, a few words of appreciation for those without whom the party couldn't function. They include the party treasurer, party members, donors, providers of goods and services, and many others. I thank them all for their steadfast support, and assure them we'll carry on working tirelessly to secure justice for men and boys (and the women who love them).
