Overview

Review of Political Activities

The behaviour of the London based parties, both inside and out of Parliament, has provided throughout 2018 ample proof, if such was needed, of the failure of the political classes in Britain today and the failure of an over-centralised form of government. The dominance of Brexit in the media has stifled debate on the other issues that matter to the people of Wessex – austerity, low wages, climate change, etc. Two initiatives have been started which will provide a sound basis for our campaigns in 2019. The new website and logo look attractive and the blogs, at least one a month, are building up a store of topics for ongoing debate, thanks to our Secretary-General, Nick Xylas. Progress on updating the Manifesto is slow but will also provide agreed policy points to bring out for public debate as needed. We were active in the public consultation of the proposals to destroy a large area of the World Heritage Site at Stonehenge for the sake of taking a few minutes off the drive from London to Cornwall. Publicity for our stance against Hinkley C nuclear power station was also disseminated. The aim for the next 12 months is to continue the social media platforms and the evolving manifesto to raise the profile of the party as a credible alternative to the main parties as well as being quicker to respond to opportunities that our Tory MPs in particular, keep providing. Our message has to focus on the need to spread power and influence in society and the economy much more widely – to the regions of the UK – to small businesses ands co-operatives.
