Introduction

For the purposes of the Political Parties Elections Referendums Act 2000, Miss Patti Goddard (the Association Chairman), is the Registered Treasurer.

Review of political activities

Overview

2015 was an exceptionally busy year politically, with the general election and a full set of local government elections polling on the same day, 7th May. Due to changes in the cycle of elections, this will only occur every twenty years.

The first six months was spent campaigning to win seats in the elections – both within the Tatton constituency and across the North West target seats.

In the second half of the year, we concentrated on fundraising.

Membership

The number of nationally qualifying members had increased to 649 at 31 December 2015, compared with 626 at 31 December 2014. 84 new members were recruited during the year, to replace members who passed away, moved out of the area or declined to renew their subscription. The age profile of the membership continues to be reduced, with more members being actively involved in campaigning and fundraising activities.

Throughout the year the branches raised funds for the Conservative Party and carried out campaign work in their geographical area. Alderley Edge branch and Wilmslow West & Chorley branch ran successful political discussion groups, considering a series of topics and putting forward members' ideas to the central Party.

The Association also runs a successful Patrons' Club and The Portcullis Club for members who wish to subscribe at a higher level. We ran a full programme of events for Team 1000 members, being political discussions.

Committees

The Association's Executive Council met three times during the year to discuss and approve the work of the Association.

The Management Committee met three times to discuss and agree the detail of the work.

Tatton Women's Committee continued to co-ordinate the activities of the Women's branches, organise the Lunch Club and run fundraising events throughout the year.

Campaigning

Our political activities focused on the general election and local government election campaigns. Leaflets and letters were delivered across the constituency as part of the election campaigns.

Rt Hon George Osborne MP was re-elected with an increased majority. In Cheshire West & Chester local authority area, 4 of our 6 candidates were elected. In Cheshire East, we were not successful in Handforth Ward, and we lost 2 seats – in Alderley Edge Ward and Wilmslow Dean Row Ward. All other Cheshire East candidates in Tatton were elected.

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2015

12 out of 15 candidates who stood for Knutsford Town Council were elected. 14 out of 15 candidates for Wilmslow Town Council were elected. Unfortunately, all 9 candidates for Alderley Edge Parish Council were not successful.

We continued to support other North West constituencies with human and financial resources to bolster their campaign success.

Staffing

In 2015 there was a change to the staffing of the Accounting Unit. The part time Campaign Intern came to the end of their twelve month contract on 1st June. Wendy Hine, who works two days a week to assist with the administration, was formally employed by the accounting unit from 1st January 2015.

We continue to benefit from the services of a full time, professional Conservative Party Agent (Hayley Wells-Bradshaw).

Overview

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The Association is showing a surplus of £23,184. Tatton contributed £5,338 to Conservative Campaign HQ.

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Income and expenditure

Income

The Income for the year amounted to £190,464 compared with £224,300 for the previous year.

Expenditure

Expenditure for the year amounted to £167,280 compared with £202,958 for the previous year.

Balance Sheet

The Association has reserves of £107,899 as at 31 December 2015 compared to £84,715 at 31 December 2014.

8. Donations

During the year the unit had donations totalling £65,930 (2014 - £95,925) that were reportable to the Electoral Commission, i.e. over £1,500 from the same donor in the year.

Within the Income and Expenditure Account the income relating to these donations is split between the Portcullis Club £50,250 (2014 - £40,625), Fundraising £Nil (2014 - £54,300), Team 1000 £4,000 (2014 - £1,000), Fighting Fund £10,600 (2014 - £Nil) and other donations (non cash) £1,080 (2014 - £Nil) captions, with only miscellaneous donations below the reporting threshold being recognized within the Donation and Other donations non-cash captions.

The total donation income included in the Income and Expenditure Account is greater than the figure reported to the Electoral Commission because of donations received below the PPERA reporting threshold.

INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF THE TATTON CONSERVATIVE ASSOCIATION

As with many other similar associations it has not been possible to verify a substantial proportion of the income from individuals and branches.
