Financial Activities

Income overview

Association income has again suffered a small decline probably due to our winning of the Northumberland seat and the feeling of content in members and activists. Fundraising continues at a steady pace and, although we show a small loss at the end of the year of £4,924, our money in the bank is £13,946. However, this is tempered by the transfer of a late £4,600 donation banked for the Northumberland Conservative Association that wasn't transferred to their account until January and must be excluded from the Berwick Conservative Association accounts.

Expenditure overview

Staff Costs and office costs have stabilised due to careful management even though campaigning activity increased significantly due to the election, with consequent increase in associated costs

Increases in campaigning activity have led to increased costs in campaign materials and associated office and printing costs.

A move of office will reduce costs in the coming year.
