For the purposes of the Political Parties Elections Referendums Act 2000, Mrs M Reader is the Registered Treasurer and Mr C Punt the deputy Registered Treasurer.

REVIEW OF POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

In 2017 there were Local Elections to SCC and in June a General Election. The Conservative majority went up to 9000. We took all bar one seat in Waveney missing that by 7 votes. There were 3 by Elections. We held Oulton Broad, took the Labour ward of St Margaret's and came a close second in Kirkley.

COMMITTEES

Waveney's Executive Council met three times during the year. The Committee is responsible for managing the business of the Association.

There is a management committee, which meets on a monthly basis and makes all day-to-day decisions.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL ACTIVITIES

Overview

This year we maintained the organisation of the Association, held Fund raising events at Constituency and Branch level. Membership recruitment was stable, which reflects us being a party in national and local government. The General and Suffolk County Council Elections dominated activity in the first part of the year. Peter Aldous MP was returned with an increased majority of over 9000 (above national swing) and the Conservatives gained all seats in Wavency bar 2 on the County Council.

Income and expenditure

Income

- We have continued with our usual range of fund raising events.
- We had a concerted campaign on membership renewal of lapsed members, which produced a rise in subscriptions.
- We had a successful Fighting Fund for the General Election which paid for most of the costs.

Expenditure

The Association's day to day costs, including staff costs and administration expenses, remained consistent. Other significant costs are paid out of the income generated for that purpose.

Balance sheet

In line with the continued improvement in our operating performance, the Association's bank balances have remained very healthy, once again.




