# Review of political activities

#### **Campaigns**

Members of Mebyon Kernow – the Party for Cornwall have been involved in a wide range of campaigns, seeking a better deal for Cornwall. These have included our calls for:

- Greater self-government for Cornwall.
- Greater recognition of Cornwall following central government's 2014
   acknowledgement that the Cornish were officially recognised as a "national
   minority" through the Framework Convention for the Protection of National
   Minorities.
- Fair funding for public services in Cornwall including the local NHS, local government, policing, etc.
- More control over planning and an end to unsustainable policies which allow inappropriate developments.
- Enhanced protection of the local environment.

Mebyon Kernow has also continued to be a strong opponent of the austerity agenda promoted by the Conservative Government.

#### 2017 local elections

A key priority for 2017/2018 was the Cornwall Council and town & parish council elections in May 2017. All four MK councillors on the unitary authority were re-elected and another member missed out by only four votes.

Twenty members were also elected to town and parish councils. One councillor has since resigned, but two additional MK members have been co-opted onto parish councils and one independent councillor on a town council also joined the Party for Cornwall.

#### Review of financial activities

Mebyon Kernow's total income in 2017-2018 was £12,251, which was up on the previous financial year when £7,526 was raised. Expenditure in 2017-2018 was £11,369, also up on the previous year when 7,706 was spent.

For the year 2017-2018 as a whole, there was a surplus of £882.
