REVIEW OF FUNDRAISING, CAMPAIGNING AND POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

Overview

The activities of the Association only really got back into gear in the second half of the year only to be derailed again – albeit temporarily with the Omicron strain of the Coronavirus. However, we managed to accomplish a reasonable amount of activity primarily due to flexibility and ingenuity – together with mastering Zoom! A number of events were planned but had to be cancelled at the last minute due to members' reluctance to attend.

The Association consists of 8 active Branches:

Easingwold & District Filey, Hunmanby & District Helmsley, Kirkbymoorside & District Hovingham, Sheriff Hutton & District Malton, Norton & District Pickering, Thornton Dale & District Thirsk, Sowerby & District Vale, Wolds & District

The Business Club events with our MP Kevin Hollinrake were restarted and 2 very successful lunches were held.

Four sessions were held in late 2021 to approve candidates for selection for the new Unitary Authority election in May 2022. By the time these sessions had been completed 26 candidates were approved.

The Conservative Policy Forum chaired by Bob Gardiner met on several occasions via Zoom to discuss Government Policy and submit members ideas to Ministers.

The Executive Council met 4 times.

Campaigning

The majority of the year was spent preparing for the elections to the new North Yorkshire Council scheduled to take place in 2022. The Association interviewed a wide-range of candidates for the 15 seats in our constituency in advance of formal selection by members. In 2022, efforts and focus will be on ensuring as many of these candidates as possible are successfully elected and that they are supported in their roles as they shape the future of local government in North Yorkshire.

Support was given, along with other associations, to our PFCC candidates to win in both elections held in 2021, in May and December. Two council by-elections were held, in Cropton and Raskelf & Whitehorse with us winning the latter seat.

Undoubtedly, the past few years of Covid has had a great effect on lives and, of course, on the Association. At the time of writing (mid-March) restrictions have been lifted and we hope events will be able to be held going forward.

From the financial perspective 2021 was an unusual year due to Covid, however a handful of successful events were held thus producing some income. The Association's resources will be under significant strain due to elections taking place in May 2022.
