Review of political activities

2021-2022 was an election year in Cornwall.

Mebyon Kernow – the Party for Cornwall put forward 19 candidates for the elections to Cornwall Council which had been reduced in size from 123 to 87 councillors. All four sitting MK councillors retained their seats, while Cllr Michael Bunney gained the division of St Mewan & Grampond. More than twenty official MK candidates were also elected to town and parish councils across Cornwall.

Following the elections, MK members have been involved in numerous campaigns, which have included calls for greater self-government for Cornwall, and action to tackle the housing crisis, protect Cornwall public services and much more.

Review of financial activities

Mebyon Kernow's total income in 2021-2022 was £11,222, which was up on the previous financial year when £7,031 was raised. Expenditure in 2021-2022 was £13,516, also up on the previous year when £6,063 was spent. The increase in expenditure was linked to the Cornwall Council and town & parish council elections which took place in May 2021.

For the year 2021-2022 as a whole, there was a deficit of £2,294.
