Overview of political activities	

We made good progress at the Ferryhill by-election in March as we ran a great campaign with a good candidate, however Labour were unusually active, with supporters arriving from across the region.

Darlington has local elections in 2023, so there has been a concerted effort to find candidates for all 50 seats and help them with action days, leaflets and surveys to increase their profile in the 20 wards. The Association has also delivered 2 town-wide leaflets in the Borough of Darlington, together with Christmas cards in key wards and Peter Gibson's regular town-wide leaflets. We continue to encourage all candidates to input as much data as possible in to Votesource so we have effective targetting in March 2023.

Financial Activities

Income overview

We started the year with a fundraising gala dinner, followed in June by a dinner with guest speaker Nadhim Zahawi MP, two quizes and a Christmas auction, however one of the biggest fundraisers was an impromptu drinks reception after the Darlington Hustings in August. Peter Gibson MP has raised over £19,766 from donors towards his incumbancy plans, which include regular town-wide newsletters, and Paul Howell MP has raised £5,150. The councillor levy and donations to the Association resulted in over £20,000 being added to our funds for future local elections.

Our bank balance increased by over £10,000 in 2022 thanks to the generosity of donors who fund regular MP newsletters and, as a result, we have a favourable financial position for 2023.

Expenditure overview

Expenditure reflects the costs associated with regular town-wide newsletters, ongoing costs for the office, which is used by CCHQ staff, and the cost of campaigning for the 2023 Darlington Council elections

Balance sheet overview

The balance sheet has increased by just over 18.45%, which leaves us in a great position for 2023.
