The balance sheet recognises the balance of transfers which are due from the Associations which previously covered the new constituency.

## Grantham and Bourne Association

"Freehold property was previously held in Trust on behalf of the Grantham & Stamford Conservative Association. Following changes to parliamentary boundaries and a reorganisation of the Associations, this has resulted in a split of beneficial interest in the freehold property held in Trust. This interest is now split between the newly formed Grantham & Bourne Conservative Association (63.75%) and Stamford & Rutland Conservative Association (36.25%).

The Trustees obtained a professional independent valuation in November 2022, which valued the property at £275,000. The Trustees and Officers of the Association consider this valuation to remain appropriate.

The transfer of £98,688 represents the Stamford & Rutland Association beneficial interest in the property.

The property continues to be held in Trust on behalf of both Associations', with any income from the Trust recognised on a received basis."

## Melton and Syston Association

Following changes to parliamentary constituency boundaries and the resulting reorganisation of the local Conservative Party Associations, the net asset value ( $\pm$ 315,675) of the Rutland and Melton Conservative Association at 13<sup>th</sup> September 2023 has been split between the newly formed Melton and Syston (49.00% =  $\pm$ 154680.75) and Stamford & Rutland Conservative Associations (51.00% =  $\pm$ 160994.25).

On 7th December, £20,000 was received as part of the split of assets and the balance of the net asset value of £140,994.25 was outstanding at 31st December 2023.
