Political activities

Overview of political activities

While there was a significant deficit in the accounts this year, a large portion of this related to campaigning for the local elections. We were successful in getting thirteen Councillors elected, so this represents a worthwhile investment of our money.

With the help of our Member of Parliament we identified additional revenue from generous benefactors both in London and South Devon. This allowed us to finance the local elections and to employ a part-time Campaign Manager, in addition to our Office Manager role.

This year was also the last one spent in our long-term home at the Conservative Club. We moved in the final weeks of December to a new, well-equipped and much larger office space in Totnes.

As ever, it is important to look at our finances over a four-year election cycle. We may well be deficit in years when there are elections, but we will probably be in surplus in non-election years. As we move in to a General Election year, the office, campaign and employment costs are significant, but we are confident that we can finance them. It is better to be an association with less funds and have a conservative MP and local Councillors, than an affluent association without them!
